The Shroud of Turin is an ancient burial cloth containing the front and back images of a scourged, crucified man that many believe is Jesus, the Christ. It is totally unique and the most studied artifact in human history.

In October of 1978, the Shroud of Turin Research Project performed the first and only in-depth scientific examination of the Shroud in its history. This team consisted of outstanding scientists and researchers chosen solely for their scientific skills and expertise. The team includedd athiests, agnostics, Jews, and Christians. They used the most advanced scientific instruments available over a period of five days and nights. Eventually, their findings were published in 24 scientific papers that appeared in highly respected peer reviewed scientific journals.

Dr. John Jackson was a member of the original team that had the unprecedented opportunity of examining the Shroud, and in his lecture he will share with the audience the opinions he formed as a result of his experience in Turin, Italy, in 1978.
