World famous photographer, Barrie Schwortz, has travelled the globe entertaining and informing audiences about the Shroud. He is featured in the Discovery Channel production "Is This the Face of Jesus?" partially filmed in Alamogordo. His photos are featured in the National Geographic June 1980 issue and in nearly every documentary and publication concerning the Shroud since 1978. Barrie was the featured guest at the grand opening of the Shroud Exhibit and Museum in 2009. He was featured recently in the "Catholic Digest." On his most recent tours, presented at the Vatican University, in Poland, to cloistered nuns, and many European audiences. We are truly blessed with the return of Barrie to our Shroud Museum in Alamogordo. This will be one of the most delightful and informative Centennial History events in our community, and we are pleased to share it with our on-line viewers.

Joining him is Dr. Petrus Soons, the only Shroud researcher in the world to create a full hologram of the Shroud who then made a life-size sculpture and has done groundbreaking 3D studies of the Shroud, creating 24-layer lenticular images which show the brightness encoding in a way that appears 3D to the naked eye.
