Announcing: A New Mexico History Celebration Event

What: "New Mexico Centennial Celebration: The Shroud of Turin Expedition." This is the 35th Anniversary year of the largest scientific expedition ever launched to study a single artifact. Forty research scientists spent five round-the-clock days, with more than 6000 pounds of modern scientific equipment, in performing an intense examination of the mysterious Shroud of Turin. The expedition was formed and launched in New Mexico in 1977. The talk will feature a full-size 2D color image of the Shroud and 3D facial, full-frontal, and full-dorsal images.

Who: Peter Schumacher, off-site tech-support for the Shroud of Turin Research Project (STURP) scientific expedition in 1978, was the Production Manager and Field Engineer for the VP-8 Image Analyzer product used in proving the Shroud image is 3D. Schumacher had installed the instruments at Sandia Laboratories in Albuquerque in 1975 and in Colorado Springs, for two Captains at the Air Force Academy, in 1976. He has studied the Shroud ever since. Schumacher is Director and Co-Founder of the Shroud Exhibit and Museum, a 501-c-3 nonprofit NM corporation located in White Sands Mall, Alamogordo, NM, where "The History of the Shroud in NM" events and Shroud studies continue.
