Deacon Pete Schumacher, a friend of local Deacon Tim Dorsey, is director of the Shroud Exhibit and Museum in Alamogordo, New Mexico. He installed a VP-8 image analyzer used in 1976 to prove the Shroud's 3D properties and produce a model of the "Man of the Shroud" displayed in the Air Force Academy Chapel since 1978. He has been featured in documentaries and seminars and led retreats and missions focused on "The Man of the Shroud".



Operating near Ft. Bliss and White Sands Missile Range, the Shroud museum recalls the efforts of those scientists of varied faith, many from our weapons and space programs of the 1970's to study the Shroud for five days and nights in Turin, Italy. Their work produced the best scientific research to date.

This is one of the most fascinating museums in New Mexico. it is in the White Sands (Shopping) Mall in Alamogordo, NM. The Shroud of Turin owns a special part of New Mexico history and was presented as part of NM Centennial celebration last year, with speakers from all over the world. It was in Albuquerque that the Shroud of Turin Research Project (STURP) began. Shroud research continues at the museum.

There is a life-size photo of the Shroud under special lighting, so it feels like you are looking at the original. There are also several "3-D" pictures of the Shroud, developed by Dr. Petrus Soons (who himself comes from South America to give presentations)--and you have to wear the 3-D glasses to view these so that they seem to come alive. Kids will love this especially!

Although the back-lit image is not portable, Deacon Pete is bringing a full-size print of the Shroud and many 3D images to this presentation. He has made presentations at many symposia and gatherings around the United States. He was a member of the STURP group and has been involved in Shroud studies since his introduction to the Shroud in 1976.
