Shroud of Turin: Looking Through the Lens of Our Faith

Are you in need of peace and reconciliation? Do you want Jesus to journey with you through this life? Consider the probability that this image accurately and clearly depicts what we read in the Gospel. These then, are the hands which touched the leper, that blessed the children, healed the sick, raised the dead to life, broke the bread and blessed the cup at the Last Supper, and the feet that trod the path to the cross to make it the altar of our salvation.

Learn how the Shroud confronts us as Christians today. On display will be a full-size, 14foot by 3.5-foot image of the Shroud, various 3D images, a study of Shroud history, including evidence of its age, and inspirational art for reflection on the personal gift of our faith.

Deacon Pete encountered the Shroud in 1976. He founded the Shroud Exhibit and Museum in Alamogordo, NM, in 2009. The exhibit is known around the globe through his seminars, lectures, presentations, retreats, and missions, and thousands of visitors to the Shroud Exhibit and Museum and its website, <u>ShroudNM.com</u>. Research continues at the museum, as evident in recent papers presented at a recent international Shroud conference.
